Enclosed is the Offsite Screening Level Exposure Assessment of Site-Associated PFAS [SLEA] – Workplan prepared by our consultant Geosyntec Consultants of NC, PC. The SLEA Workplan supports characterizing human health exposure pathways and will also present a focused hazard characterization to help prioritize environmental contact media and intake pathways.

Geosyntec recommended conducing the SLEA, which is not required by the Consent Order, to support corrective action decision making at the Fayetteville Works and surrounding area. Chemours agreed to support conducting the SLEA. We would welcome your comments on this SLEA strategy.

Chemours plans to submit the SLEA, and supporting documentation, in concert with the forthcoming Corrective Action Plan, on or before December 31, 2019.
